Rules and Definitions

- Men's 6 v 6 one of which must be the Goalie
- All team members must be in matching color shirts
- Games start on time,
- Minimum # of team players to start a game is 4
- Failure to have 4 players at game time results in forfeiture.
- Two 22 minute halves and a 3 minute halftime.
- 1 Referee is to be from the designated team on the schedule
- Failure to have a referee represented results loss for the scheduled referee's team for that week.
- Slide tackles from behind are not allowed! (Automatic red card and the team plays a man down for the remainder of the game.)
- Each team brings its own balls
- No offsides
- Open substitutions Any Time: the player leaving the pitch must be off of the pitch before the new player may enter the pitch.
- Referees are to report scores to clarkk@prudentialutah.com or text the result to 801-372-3858
- Over time will consist of a 5 minute golden goal period. If a goal is scored in the golden goal period, the game is over. If the game is still tied after this period, then a round of three penalty kicks per team will follow. The goal keeper that was in the goal at the end of the golden goal period must remain in the goal for the shootout. If the game is still tied, teams will go to 1 to 1 penalty kicks. No player can kick a second time in penalty kicks until the whole team has kicked.
- Goal Kicks: Any goal kick can be placed anywhere within the goal box.
- Throw-Ins: Any ball that fully goes out of bounds on the east or west sides of the field will be thrown back in, all FIFA rules for throw-ins apply.
- Corner Kicks: Ball will be placed and kicked in the corner of the field (depending on what side of the goal it went out on). The person kicking the corner CAN score.
- Goal Keepers: Goalies can use their hands within the box area, as long as the ball was not passed to the goalie with the feet of a team member. If a goalie miss touches the ball inside of the area the opposing team will be rewarded an indirect kick (not penalty) from 10 Yard Line. The goalie can throw, punt, drop-kick, or pass the ball out of this area.

- Forfeits: If both teams happen to forfeit, it will be recorded as a mutual loss. Kick Off: The ball will be placed in the exact middle of the field and can be kicked off in any direction.
- Penalty Kicks: If the official believes that a scoring chance was nullified by a foul, the team fouled will be awarded a penalty kick. A penalty kick is a direct kick, where the ball is placed 10 yards in front of the goal. All other players must stand behind the player kicking the ball. In the event of a missed penalty kick, and the ball is in play, the game resumes with the ball in play.
- Direct Kicks: For which the other team receives a "direct free kick." A goal can be scored directly from the kick. Fouls include:
 1. Kicking or attempting to kick an opponent. To prevent injuries, intentional or not, this foul will always be called.
 2. Tripping or attempting to trip an opponent.
 3. Charging into an opponent.
 4. Striking or attempting to strike an opponent.
 5. Blatant holding or pulling of an opponent.
 6. Making contact with an opponent before touching the ball. This includes when going up for a jump ball.
 7. Dangerous play: consists of other fouls that a referee would consider "dangerous," such as heading a low ball that could be kicked, or bringing your feet up high to kick a ball when another player is within playing distance of the ball.
 8. Stopping the progress of an opponent: includes setting picks on players without the ball, or stopper another player's movement towards the ball.
 9. Preventing the goaltender from releasing the ball: players must allow the goalkeeper to put the ball in play.
